Course Objectives: This course is an introduction to internal accounting. Emphasis is on the use of accounting information in controlling the operations of a business. Specific areas covered include CVP analysis, cost analysis, budgeting, segment reporting, responsibility accounting, capital budgeting, relevant costing, the cash flow statement and financial statement analysis. The fundamental accounting concepts and techniques for planning and control studied are applicable to all types of businesses and organizations.

Prerequisite: AC111 and AC112 or equivalent

Text: Managerial Accounting, 10th ed., by Garrison & Noreen, Published by McGraw-Hill Irwin.
